Summer reading expectations: Incoming 6th graders are required to read at least one book this summer, and complete one video booktalk using Flipgrid. The **Grade 6 Summer Reading Fligrid** (a daily grade in English class) will be used as a starting point this fall for discussions about great books to read.



First, **join** our HCMS Grade 6 Summer Reading Flipgrid. Flipgrid is a safe and private website and app where students can create book talk videos and share what they are reading with other HCMS students.

Signing Up for Flipgrid:

<u>Device app option</u>: 1) Download the Flipgrid app from Self Service or App Store 2) Click on "I am a Student." 3) enter grid code <u>27ae57</u> 4) enter password: **hcms6**

Computer option: 1) Click this link: https://flipgrid.com/27ae57 2) enter password: hcms6

Now add a book talk:

Click the plus sign, and record yourself giving a book talk. You have 2 minutes to create your video.

Use the following script to guide your book talk:

My name is ...

(As you hold up the book) The book I read was (title) ... by (author) ...

The book was about ... (tell enough to interest the audience but don't give away too much!) I thought this book was ... (How many stars? Reason you liked it? etc.)

The cover image for your Flipgrid should be a picture of YOU holding the book (and only that!).
